COOKIE POLICY

1. SCOPE

- 1.1. UnosplICE Group ("UnosplICE", "Company," "we," "our," or "us"), through this Cookie Policy, explains how we use cookies and similar technologies to recognize you when you visit our website, www.unosplICE.com, ("Website"). It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as your rights to control our use of them.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

- 2.1. A cookie is a small file, typically of letters and numbers, downloaded to a user's computer or mobile device when the user accesses certain websites. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user's device. They are used for a wide variety of purposes such as website analytics – counting visitors and their behavior, targeted advertising, recording user preferences, identification, gathering information about their usage of the website and their presumed interests, or for authentication purposes.
- 2.2. Further, cookies are necessary to provide certain functionalities on a website, such as, to maintain a language choice made by a user. The sections below further elucidate the purpose of cookie collection.

3. WHY DO WE USE COOKIES, DATA COLLECTED

- 3.1. Cookie information is used to improve the website and to deliver relevant advertisements for our products and services on the website as well as on third party sites.
- 3.2. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember your preferences and generally work for the purpose of improving the user experience. They can also help to ensure that the advertisements you see online are more relevant to you and your interests. In addition, cookies can help us to analyze the use of our websites and online content (analytics cookies) and they can also facilitate/track the interaction on our websites and online content with social media (e.g. links to social media sites, like buttons, etc.).
- 3.3. Cookies can be assigned to four categories, depending on their function and intended purpose: strictly necessary cookies, performance cookies, functionality cookies, and marketing cookies. The same is highlighted in the section below.

4. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

- 4.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies - These cookies are vital for the website's operation and cannot be disabled within our systems. They are typically activated in response to actions you take, such as adjusting privacy settings, logging in, or completing forms. While you can configure your browser to block or notify you about these cookies, certain parts of the site may become inaccessible. Importantly, these cookies do not retain any personally identifiable information.
- 4.2. Performance cookies - These cookies enable us to track visits and traffic sources, facilitating the assessment and enhancement of our site's performance. They provide insights into page popularity and visitor navigation patterns. All data collected by these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you opt out of these cookies, we won't be able to track your site visits or monitor its performance.
- 4.3. Functionality cookies - These cookies enhance website functionality and personalize user experiences. They may be placed by us or third-party providers whose services we've integrated into our pages. Disabling these cookies may result in some services functioning improperly or not at all.
- 4.4. Targeting Cookies - These cookies may be deposited by our site's advertising partners to create a profile of your interests and display relevant ads on other websites. They don't store personal information directly but rather rely on identifying your browser and internet device uniquely. Rejecting these cookies will reduce the frequency of targeted advertising you encounter.

5. THIRD PARTY COOKIES

- 5.1. Our website utilizes third-party cookies to enhance user experience and provide personalized content and advertisements. These cookies may be set by external service providers whose functionalities we integrate into our website. Third-party cookies enable us to analyze website traffic, track user interactions, and deliver targeted advertising based on your browsing history and interests.
- 5.2. By using our website, you consent to the use of third-party cookies as described in this policy. You have the option to manage your cookie preferences through your browser settings or by opting out of specific third-party services. However,

please note that disabling third-party cookies may affect the functionality and performance of certain features on our website.

- 5.3. We do not have control over third-party cookies, and their usage is subject to the respective privacy policies of the external service providers. We recommend reviewing the privacy policies of these third parties for more information on how they collect, use, and disclose your personal data through cookies.

6. YOUR CHOICES

- 6.1. You can change your cookies preference any time from Cookie Settings.

You can adjust your browser settings to accept or reject cookies or to notify you when a cookie is set. Please consult your browser's help menu for instructions on how to do this.
- 6.3. Please note that if you choose to disable cookies, you may not be able to access certain parts of our website or experience the full functionality of the site.

7. HOW WE USE COLLECTED DATA

- 7.1. The data collected through cookies on our website is utilized for various purposes to improve user experience, personalize content, and analyze website performance. Without prejudice to or excluding the purposes set out elsewhere under this Cookie Policy and our Privacy Policy, we may use data collected through cookies for various purposes, including but not limited to for the purpose of:

- 7.1.1. Website Functionality: We use cookies to ensure the proper functioning of our website, including remembering your preferences, login credentials, and settings.
- 7.1.2. Performance Tracking: Cookies enable us to track website traffic, analyze user interactions, and measure the performance of our website. This helps us understand how visitors use our site, which pages are most popular, and identify areas for improvement.
- 7.1.3. Personalization: We may use cookies to personalize your experience on our website by presenting content and advertisements tailored to your interests and browsing behavior.
- 7.1.4. Security: Cookies are utilized to enhance the security of our website, detect and prevent fraudulent activity, and ensure the integrity of user accounts and data.
- 7.1.5. Analytics: We employ cookies to gather information for analytics purposes, such as understanding user demographics, geographic location, and device preferences. This data is aggregated and anonymized to protect your privacy.
- 7.1.6. Marketing and Advertising: Cookies may be used for marketing and advertising purposes, including tracking the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns, delivering targeted advertisements, and measuring engagement with our promotional content.
- 7.1.7. Third-Party Services: We may integrate third-party services that use cookies for additional functionality, such as social media plugins, embedded content, and external analytics tools. These third parties have their own privacy policies governing the use of cookies and data collected through their services.

8. CHANGES TO THIS COOKIE POLICY

- 8.1. Subject to applicable laws, we reserve the right to modify or revise this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices or for other operational, legal, or regulatory reasons. We encourage you to review this policy periodically for any updates.

- 9.1. By registering on, accessing, browsing, downloading, or using this website for any general purpose or for the specific purpose of availing any product or service offered by us, you agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in this Cookie Policy.

- 10.1. To the extent that any provision in this Cookie Policy is found to be invalid or unenforceable, such provision shall be modified in such a manner so as to make this Cookie Policy as modified, legal and enforceable under applicable laws.
